General Responsibilities:

Licensed Airframe and Powerplant technician to perform aircraft maintenance and other duties as assigned

Duties:

Reports to the DOM and Lead Technician. Will perform diagnostic and mechanical duties on a variety of corporate and private aircraft including troubleshooting airframes and systems, overhauling jet engines, replacing parts and components, performing progressive inspections and modifications on customer aircraft.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Perform organizational, intermediate, and heavy maintenance, modification and repair of aircraft systems. Services, removes, repairs, replaces, modifies and installs functional components, mechanical and electromechanical systems in accordance with Maintenance Manuals and test procedures to ensure airworthiness. The systems include, oxygen, pneumatic, hydraulic, environmental, egress and fuel systems. Performs rigging of control surfaces and services aircraft. Uses hand tools, power tools, gauges and test equipment. Follows and interprets engineering drawings, standards, safety directives and Maintenance Manuals to determine feasibility and method of repairing or replacing malfunctioning or damaged components. Documents work performed in aircraft forms, records and workbooks.

Experience, Training, Education:

Seven to ten years experience in heavy maintenance of the Cessna Citation 550/560/650 series aircraft, King Air 200/350 series aircraft and the Learjet 20/30 series aircraft. Pratt and Whitney PT6A and Honeywell TFE731 experience a plus. Must possess Airframe and Powerplant license. Understands, reads, and writes English. Knowledge of maintenance and inspection procedures, minimum seven years. Outstanding customer service skills a must.

Materials and Equipment:

Must have basic mechanics hand tools

Working Conditions:

Candidate must be willing to obtain a US Passport and be willing to travel to accommodate AOG repairs and recovery. May be required to work in areas that are noisy, dusty, and dirty. May be exposed to moderate discomforts, such as heat, cold and wind. This position requires physical activity; work may include frequent bending, reaching and climbing. Work may be performed on top or under equipment in cramped or awkward positions. May frequently lift and carry items weighing up to fifty pounds and occasionally lift heavier items with the assistance of other workers. May be required to wear personal protective equipment.

Must be willing to travel when needed, circumstances may include short notice. May be required to work some nights and weekends.
